The evening reception held at Leeuwenhof, Helen Zille's official residence, emphasised how important the initiative is to her personally.

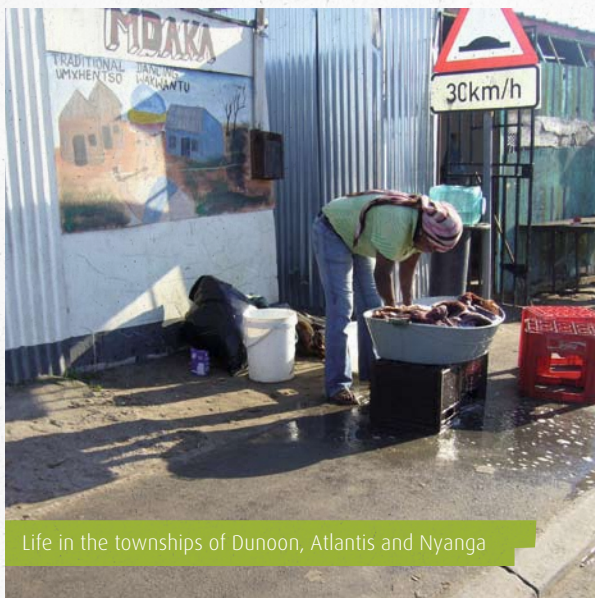

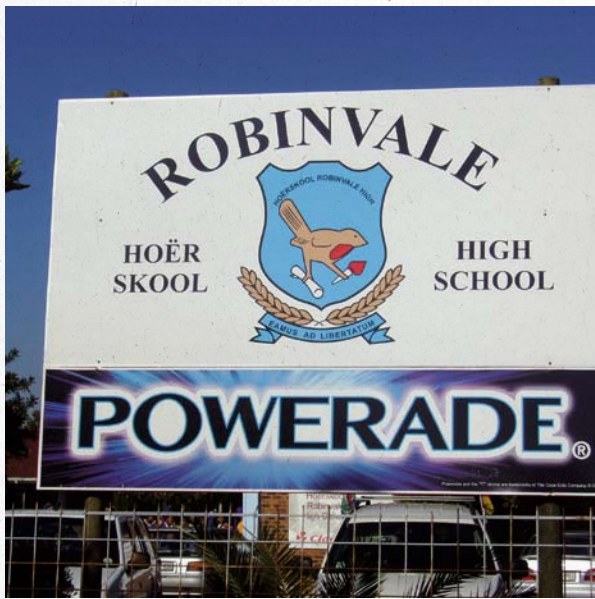




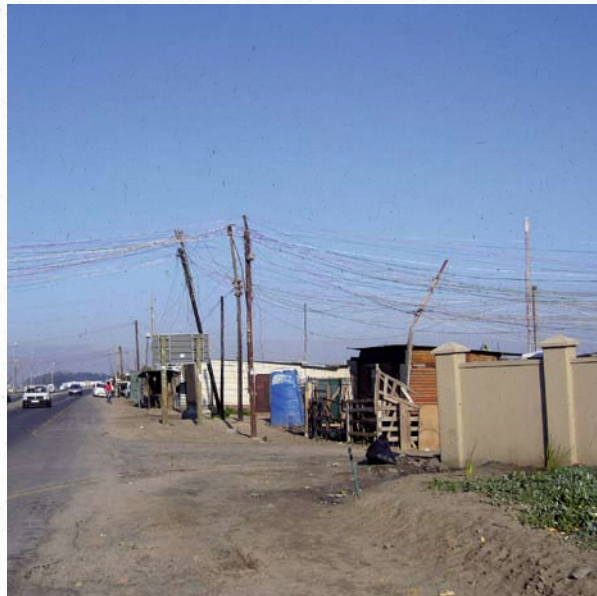
